

PRESS RELEASE 66**TPWODL Organises Health Camps and Awareness Drives in Rural Odisha under Tata Volunteer Week 2024**

Sambalpur, September 13, 2025: As part of Tata Volunteer Week 24 and under its CSR initiatives, TP Western Odisha Distribution Limited (TPWODL) organised a series of impactful community outreach programs to improve healthcare access and awareness in rural Odisha.

An Eye Check-up Camp was held on Dt. 11.09.25 at Khajurpada, under Bolangir district, where 177 villagers received free consultations. Spectacles were provided to those in need, helping restore clear vision and enhancing their quality of life. For many beneficiaries, this support meant the ability to work, study, and live with dignity.

On Dt. 12.09.25, a similar Eye Check-up Camp at Babuji Club under Sonepur witnessed enthusiastic community participation. A total of 65 villagers benefitted from free eye examinations, and spectacles were distributed to those who required them.

TPWODL also focused on women's health and hygiene. In the villages of Kandama, Bondel, and Musanal under Kalahandi district, a Sanitary Health Awareness Drive was conducted on Dt. 12.09.25. More than 120 women and girls benefitted from awareness sessions on menstrual hygiene, along with the distribution of sanitary pads to encourage safe and healthy practices.

Through these initiatives, TPWODL reaffirmed its commitment to community well-being and inclusive development, extending its role beyond power supply to empower rural communities with better health and awareness.

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
